No weapons, tobacco or alcohol to be sold. Registration payment by cash only, paid on entry. No refund or credit will be issued after payment. If you're unable to attend, you're to notify WHAM well in advance so we can allocate your space to another vendor. ALL unsold items must be taken off site at the end of the event and the space left clean and tidy. All items must be sold from within the 10' by 10' space. Car's, SUV's, Mini-vans and pick-up trucks will be allowed. Vendor vehicle to be parked within space with 10' by 10' space starting at the end of vehicle trunk. **All vendors must arrive between 7:00am–7:30am** for set-up and ready to sell by 8:00am. The seller is responsible for all tables, supplies, etc. This is an uncovered car park concrete, gravel and grass venue, be prepared for the sun and rain – we can't predict the weather. All spaces are assigned by museum staff and are final. Entry on a first come, first served basis. Terms and Conditions are subject to change by WHAM.
